2. A brief **summary** if the novel(15 points) _____
3. Use pictures (at least 2) from magazine(s), computer, or hand drawn **images that relate** to the text to create visual interest for your audience. (10 points) _____
4. Use two or more **significant passages** from the selection. Copy the passage exactly as written and use quotation marks. Provide a brief explanation of why you selected the passage and explore their importance to the novel. (10 Points) _____
5. Write a **personal statement** about what you have read. (15 points) _____
6. Find an example of each: **Imagery/Allusions** from the novel. Write the sentences exactly as they are in the novel and explain them. (20 points) _____
7. **Figurative Language:** Identify three examples and explain them from the following list: symbolism, idiom, euphemism, simile, metaphor, flashback, foreshadow, personification, irony. (20 points) _____
